- Excellent Career and Technical Education Participation

- Favorable Revisions/Changes
 - Restoration of Resource and Process Standards
 - Will be revised by state advisory teams to update
 - Retention of Statement Regarding Graduates Completing CTE Programs
 - Reduction of Required EOCs



End-of-Course Situation

- Board Goal: 3 high school level EOCs for each of four content areas
- Mathematics assessments not yet determined, so CTE participation is necessary
- Science standards available fall, 2012; CTE participation again necessary

ESEA Flexibility

- State Chiefs created initial document on Next-Generation State Accountability Systems
- CCSSO working closely with Department of Education
- States can design accountability system that fits needs



ESEA Flexibility

- Opportunity for Waiver of some NCLB Accountability Requirements
 - 2014 timeline for achieving 100% proficiency
 - School and district accountability requirements
 - Various program and fund restrictions
