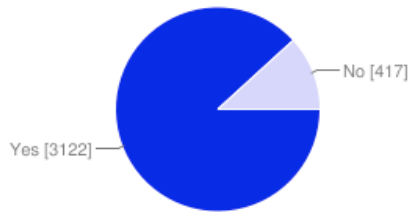

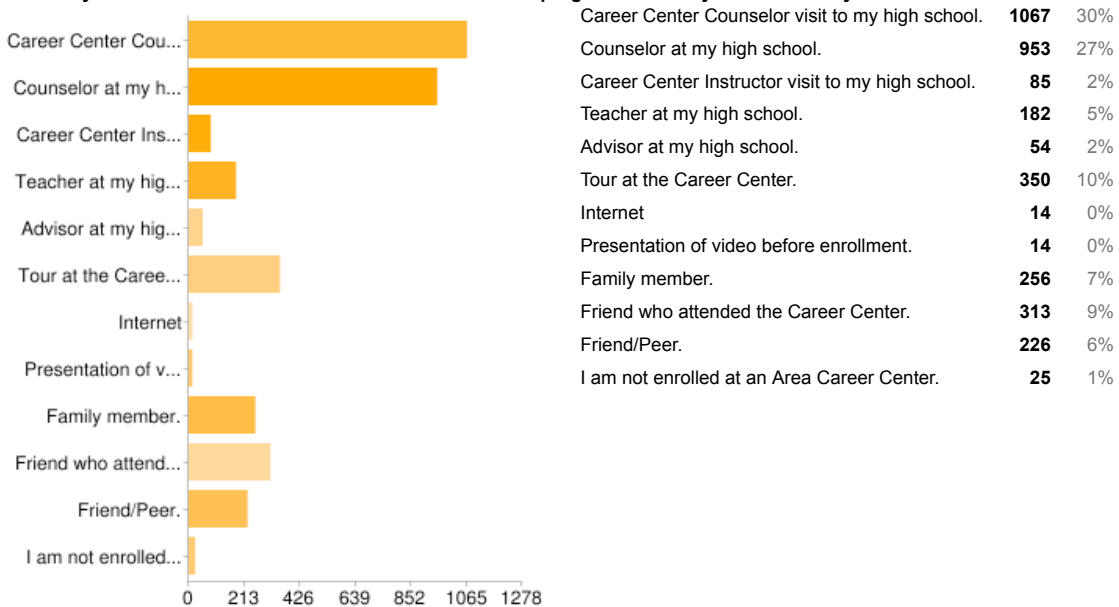

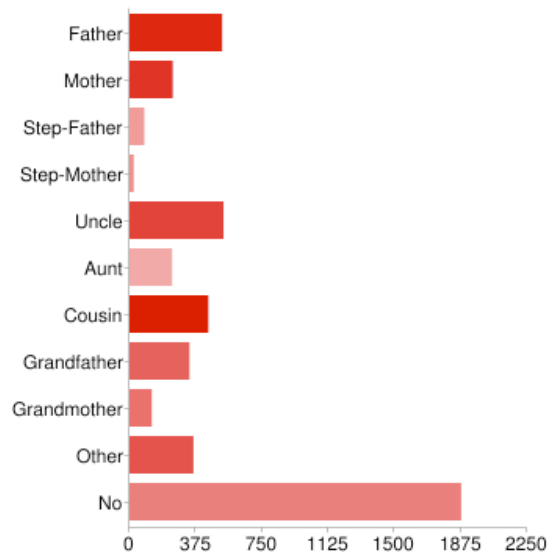

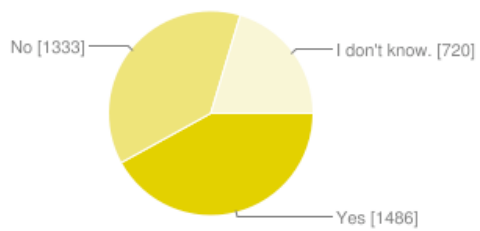

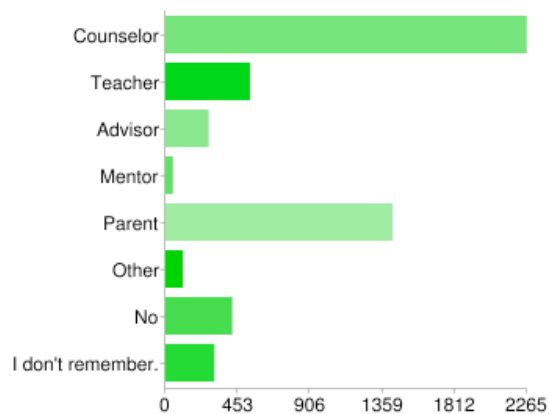

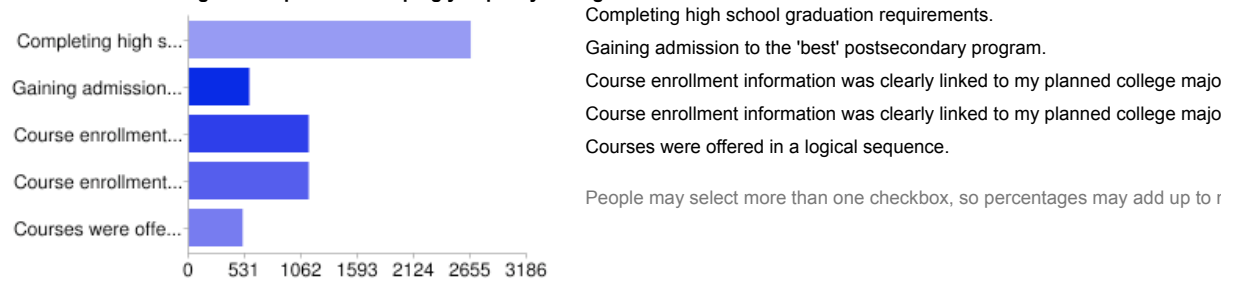

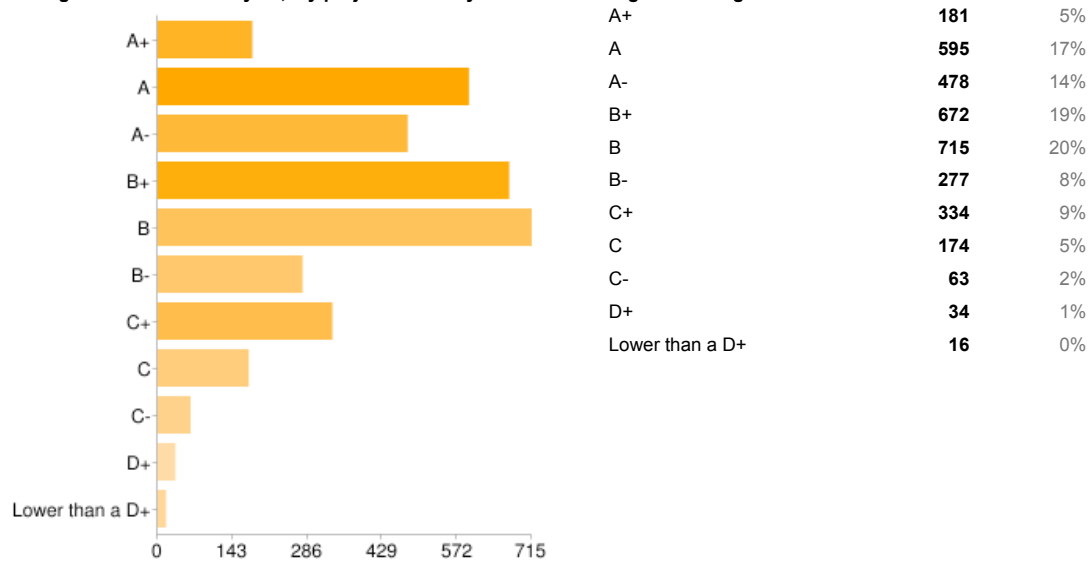

During the current school year, my projection for my combined class grade average would be:



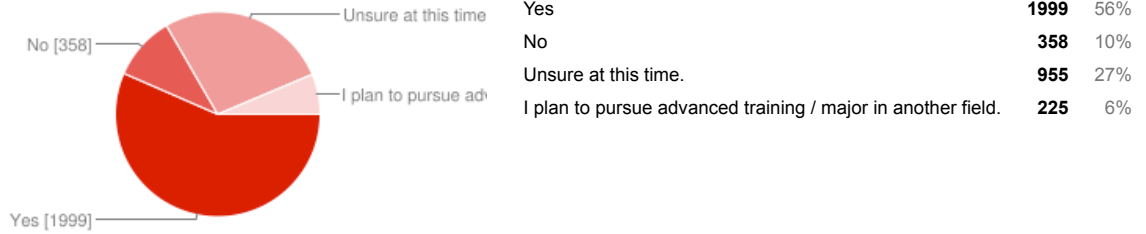

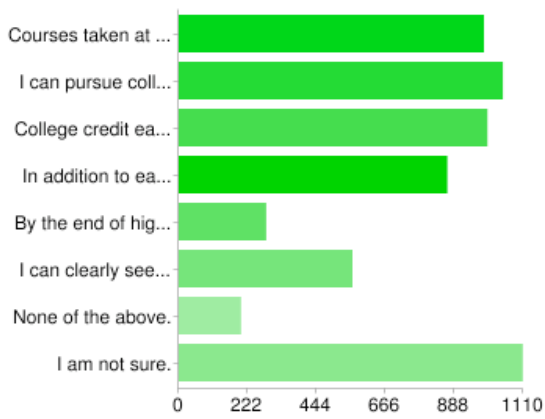

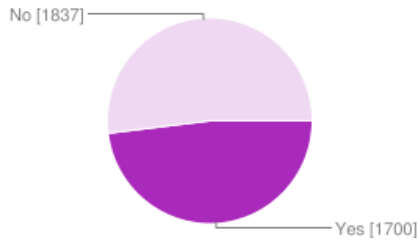

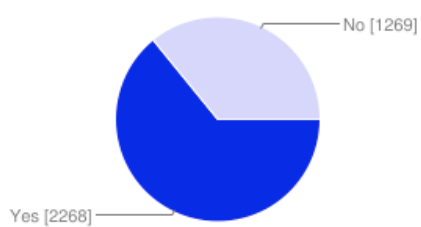

Would you prefer to take necessary 'developmental courses' in mathematics and communication arts while still in high school?



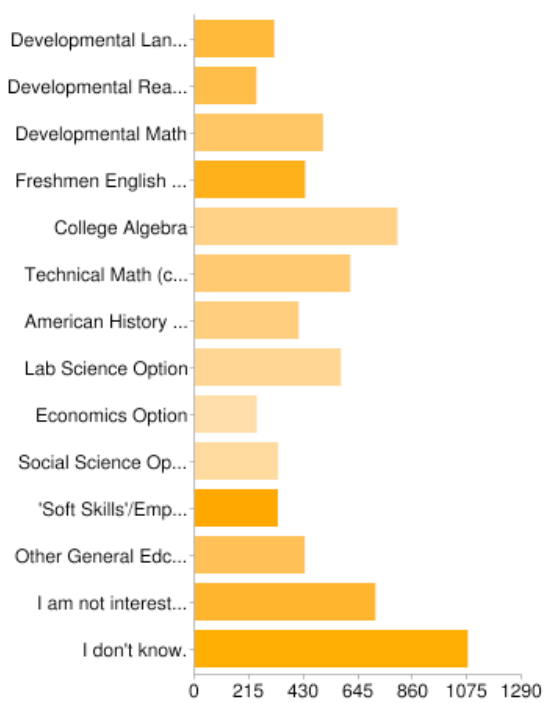

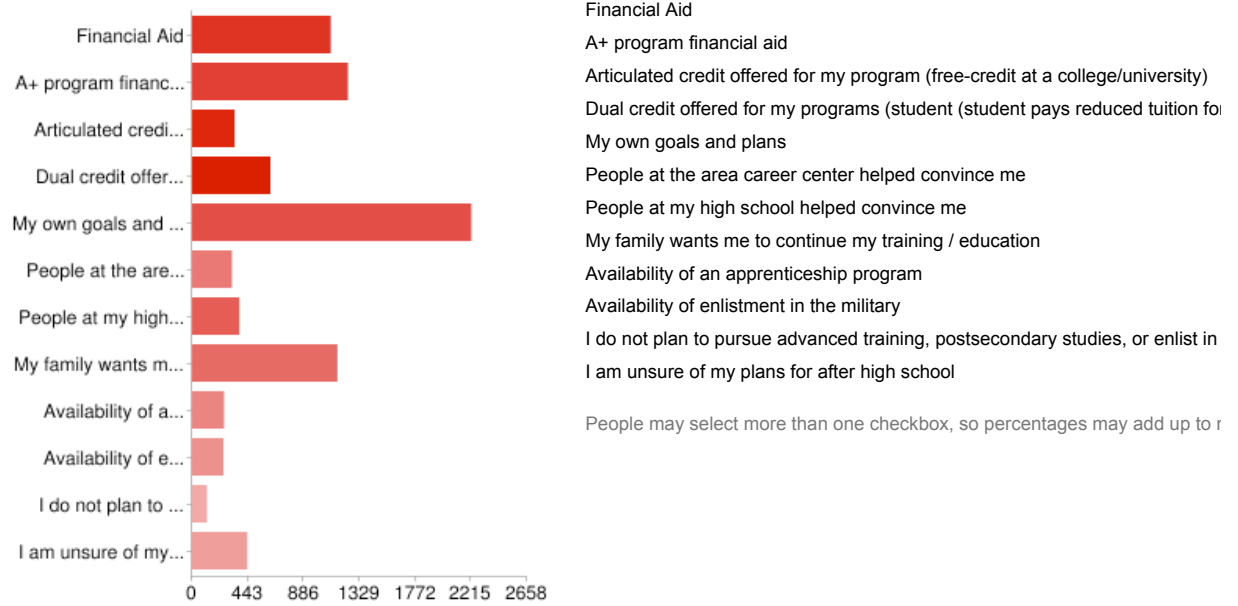

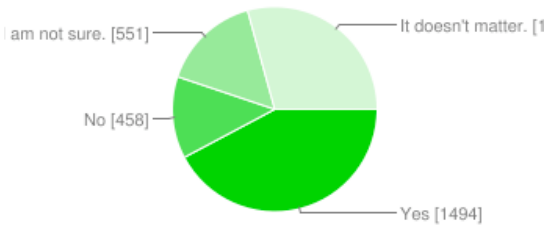

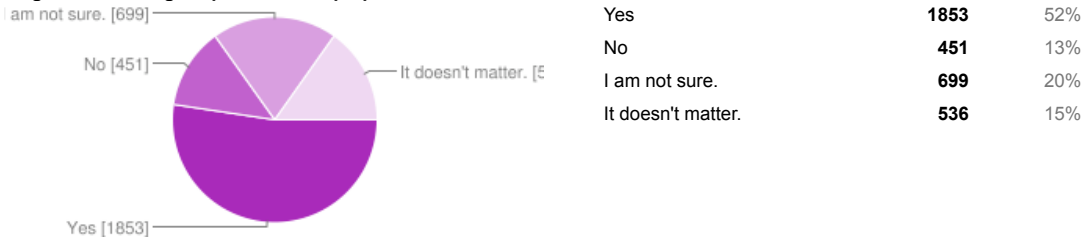


If area career centers offered college courses I believe they should be taught by college professors?

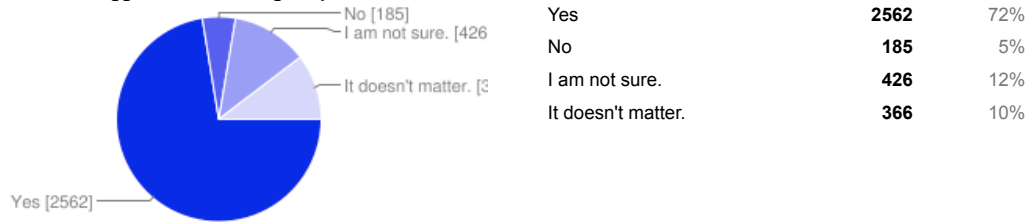

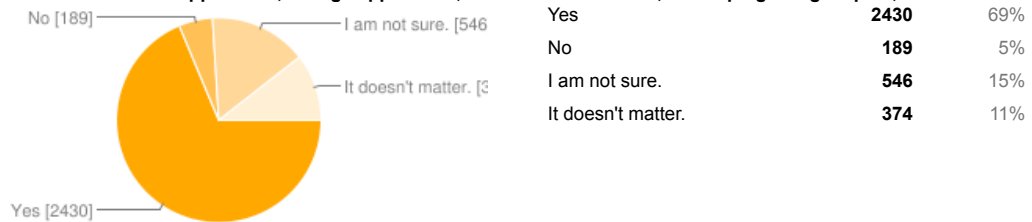

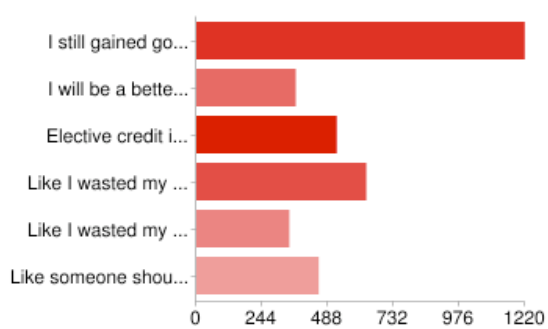

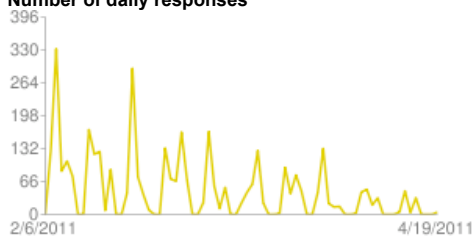
